Dr. Copelin, why are you so passionate about being a voice for young girls and women worldwide?

I was first diagnosed with a mental illness at the age of 12, battling depression, anxiety, and several other illnesses. Through my work with my organization, Mental Rich, I am a voice for young girls and women suffering from depression, anxiety, or any other disorders, due to abuse, abandonment and rejection. I act as a support system and advocate a message of hope, encouragement and support. I have always been passionate about helping others since I was a young girl. I am a natural caregiver and am looking to make a difference. Growing up, I didn't have a mentor and I want to be that support system for young girls and women.

Dr. Copelin, you are the founder of Mental Rich. Please tell readers more about your mental health movement?

Mental Rich, is a mental health movement dedicated to helping women of color who suffer from mental illnesses, steaming from abuse, abandonment and rejection. Mental health is a topic of conversation currently in the community but there are other issues that need to be addressed. I use my platform to bring awareness to things and issues many don't see, know or unable to speak about.

Please tell readers more about your experiences of mental illness due to abuse, rejection and abandonment?

Speaking from experience, I grew up in a culture that tells us "we are to be strong," that we "should deal with problems on our own." This only enforces the idea that it is not okay for us to say we are hurting inside. I have spoke to countless friends who say "you don't suffer from mental health illnesses and you should pray." I do pray, daily; however, I also need to be realistic and understand that I do suffer from mental health illnesses and I do need to seek additional help, such as counseling. Just a few years ago, I took 70 pills and was sent to an inpatient mental health facility for 6 days.

How are you using your mental health experiences to help others who are suffering?

I act as a support system and advocate a message of hope, encouragement and support. Education is key and I plan to take my message to Congress later in 2020 to lend my voice to mental health awareness.

What are you currently working on?

I am currently working on several wellness retreats and seminars, in addition to several other programs/products that lend a voice to the stigma of mental health among young girls and women.

What can people expect from you in 2020?

I have so much planned for 2020. I am working on Mental Rich and will be launching several products and services. I also will be speaking throughout 2020, advocating for mental health.

What is one thing 2019 taught you?

One thing that 2019 taught me was to set boundaries with people. Boundaries are essential to healthy relationships and, really, a healthy life.

She is also in the process of planning her 4th annual Breathe Women's Retreat which is being held in Ochos Rios in May 2020. Her skills will soon take her all the way to London, England to speak at the MizCEO Entrepreneurial Conference in April 2020. These are just some of the "greater and bigger" that await Giovanna. Giovanna's impact crosses the city and state lines through her weekly podcast and radio show, as well as through her book – Why Am I Still Single, which was featured in the Essence Music Festival bookstore in 2018 and 2019.

Committed to being a resource to victims of sex trafficking, sexual assault and domestic violence through empowerment, financial support and volunteerism, Giovanna launched the 100 Women in White this past summer.

What's next for Giovanna, aside from being a loving wife, mother, having a 2 month waitlist in her practice, traveling to be a guest speaker, hosting retreats and conferences, helping people heal and give themselves permission to rest and stop drowning in the busyness of life? It's a new book called Epiphany...scheduled for release in early 2020.

Inhale. Now, exhale. Inhale. Now, exhale. Giovanna knows she is doing what she was created to do. Since the best is yet to come and she knows she has to trust the process, we still haven't seen Giovanna's best...yet!

C.R.O.W.N. Program(Communities Reaching Our Widespread Needs) is committed to providing hairpieces, wigs, weaves, cosmetics, and hair assistance to financially disadvantage and underserved individuals who m suffer from long-term medical hair loss from any medical diagnosis.

Diamond G.E.M.S. (Graceful Elderly Matriarchs Shine) Often times elderly individuals are underserved. They are diamonds in the rough. Diamonds are valuable and treasured and their rarity has caused people and nations to passionately seek after them.

Our Diamond G.E.M.S. are full of wisdom that touch our lives to grow and birth us to our destinies. Many Diamond G.E.M.S. serve as midwives, guiding us in wisdom and soundness, helping us birth dreams and visions. Unfortunately, they are too, among the

abused. In great numbers we are seeing more of these precious GEMS go under-served and even taken advantage of. We assist our G.E.M.S. by coming to senior homes, senior sleep-overs and lock-ins, senior pageants, and senior outreach programs. We have provided programs from managing and understanding bank statements and reconciling check books to turning on a computer and using social media and networking. Beautify the Meek does everything from makeovers to providing motivational training and seminars.


